- 1. Prepares students for their future: stimulates curiosity, creativity, initiative (grit), multidisciplinary thinking, self reflection and awareness, and empathy
- 2. Supports students as leaders of their own learning, educators as activators of learning, and systems that are dedicated to continuous growth
- 3. Anchors on a cluster of interdisciplinary standards
- 4. Emphasizes problem/solution-based units of study anchored on inquiry
- Includes clear learning sequences and uses evidence of student learning fluidly and formatively to move learning forward
- 6. Differentiates research-supported instructional practices to move learning forward
- Enriches professional learning through well-resourced units of study that are implemented and evaluated by strong collaborative teams of educators
- 8. Ensures that strategic plans, school improvement efforts, and collaborative teams flourish
