1. Prepares students for their future: stimulates curiosity, creativity, initiative (grit), multidisciplinary thinking, self reflection and awareness, and empathy
2. Supports students as leaders of their own learning, educators as activators of learning, and systems that are dedicated to continuous growth
3. Anchors on a cluster of interdisciplinary standards
4. Emphasizes problem/solution-based units of study anchored on inquiry
5. Includes clear learning sequences and uses evidence of student learning fluidly and formatively to move learning forward
6. Differentiates research-supported instructional practices to move learning forward
7. Enriches professional learning through well-resourced units of study that are implemented and evaluated by strong collaborative teams of educators
8. Ensures that strategic plans, school improvement efforts, and collaborative teams flourish
