School Improvement Planning

A Process for Planning, Monitoring, and Reporting



- 1. Involves all stakeholders actively in the creation and implementation of the plan
- Determines school goals based upon school's areas for growth and district-wide broad strategic goals
- 3. Identifies indicators for school success and analyzes data frequently (minimally monthly), including disaggregated data.
- 4. Publishes areas of strengths and areas for growth for all stakeholders to analyze and act on
- 5. Ensures and reflects a systematic understanding of best instructional strategies
- 6. Identifies action steps, including best instructional strategies, to implement
- 7. Emphasizes differentiated professional learning based upon the needs of the staff
- 8. Monitors progress towards goals, tracks impact, and involves mid-course corrections as needed
- 9. Communicates effectively with all stakeholders, gaining their support and celebrating the schools' success
